Any interested person may testify at the hearings, provided that he or she gives written notice to the Director of the Division of Financial Institutions of his or her intention to do so at least five (5) days prior to the commencement of the hearings. In the event that the deadline for the filing of such notice falls on a day when the Division of Financial Institutions is not open for business, then the deadline shall be extended to the next available date on which the Division is open for business. Any person failing to file timely notice of his or her intention to testify will not be permitted to testify at the public hearings. In addition, any interested person may make a written submission of his or her views, comments, data or arguments by filing said written submission with the Director of the Division of Financial Institutions no later than 5:00 PM on the last day of the scheduled public hearings, except as to all written submissions which set forth information in the nature of expert testimony. All written submissions which set forth the information in the nature of expert testimony and/or opinions, including but not limited to statistical data, compilations, charts, diagrams, accounting procedures and/or computer printouts, must be filed with the Director of the Division of Financial Institutions at least 15 days prior to the first public hearing along with ten copies of each such written submission. Any written submission which is not timely filed will not be considered by the Director in establishing the maximum rate schedules. Notice of intent to testify and written submissions may be filed in person or by mail with the Director of the Division of Financial Institutions either at the James P. Thompson Center, 100 W. Randolph Street, Ninth Floor, Chicago, Illinois 60601, or at 320 W. Washington Street, Springfield, Illinois 62786.
