DEPARTMENT RESILIENCE AMIDST COVID-19

Although our physical offices are closed to the public out of health and safety concerns due to the COVID-19 virus, Department personnel continue to work to ensure continuity during this time. Most are working remotely and rotating into the office to allow for proper safety measures to be observed. As a result of these changes, we appreciate your patience as many items may take longer to process than usual.

Below are a few of the process/procedural changes:

- Board meetings scheduled during this time have changed to a web-based platform, been postponed or have been cancelled if unavoidable.
- Personnel from multiple areas of the Professional Regulation Division, including personnel from the Design Unit
 have begun temporarily assisting with processing of health profession licensures and renewals due to the high
 demand and need for physicians, nurses, etc. at this time so these professionals can help those affected or potentially affected by COVID-19.
- Many professions regulated by the Department with a license renewal for April 30th, 2020 have been extended through July 2020 and also have had continuing education requirement changes as a result of certain in-person restrictions.
- Please note, <u>at this time</u>, no changes for renewals have been implemented for the Architect, Land Surveyor or Structural Engineer professions that are scheduled to renew this year on November 30, 2020.
- Design Profession license applications are being reviewed electronically by staff or the Board as required by the respective statute.
- Exam/license certifications are being processed, but may take additional time to complete if required to retrieve microfilm to determine exam information as personnel are not always in the office when the request is received.

Exceptions to this law exist only for law enforcement, other regulatory agencies with appropriate regulatory interest, or a party presenting a lawful subpoena.
